



Midtown Mosaic Art Show and Sale - 2026

Information for Artists/exhibitors

Registration

Midtown Mosaic committee members are responsible for inviting artists to display their work at our sale. We will provide you with either 2 double sided easels and one 4' table, or one 6' table. Our intention is to offer each artist an 8'X8' footprint. We will be accepting a maximum of 25 artists. Artists will be required to pay a \$40 fee upon registration. To support the event and its ongoing success, St. Stephen's will retain a 20% commission on the first \$1,000 in sales, followed by a 5% commission should you exceed \$1,000 in sales.

Set up

Artwork will be set up by the artists on Friday, October 2, between 1:00 and 4:00 PM.

Artwork

Midtown Mosaic is not responsible for damaged or stolen artwork. Any insurance coverage is the responsibility of the artist.

Labels

All artwork must be labelled. Every item you have for sale in the show should have a uniquely coded number that identifies it as one of your works and corresponds to the inventory list you submitted. Your code will consist of the first three letters of your last name, plus a number for the individual piece. (ex: Bri – 1, Bri – 2 etc). Your code and number is vital in recording any sales and ensuring payment is made to you.

Inventory List

List all the artwork you are exhibiting in the show, along with your coded number for each, and the price. Please note that GST will not be added to any sales. If GST applies to you, please let us know, as that will alter our bookkeeping practices.

Sales

All sales during the show will be processed by the Midtown Mosaic committee at St. Stephen's church and artists will be paid by e-transfer the week following the sale. To support the event and its ongoing success, St. Stephen's will retain a 20% commission on the first \$1,000 in sales, followed by a 5% commission should you exceed \$1,000 in sales.

Name tags

Artist name tags will be provided by the committee at the show. Please wear your name tag for the duration of the show.

Food

Coffee, tea and cold drinks will be available for participating artists in the Creation Space in the basement of the church. There is elevator access if needed. A light meal will be provided for artists each day.

Parking

After unloading your work, please park your vehicle in the lot at Connaught school. (One and a half blocks away - off 10th Street, between 12th and 13th Avenue) We would like to leave the limited parking behind the church and on the street for guests of the show - for the people buying your work!

Door Prizes

Visitors to the show will be asked to fill out a draw ticket that includes their contact information and feedback on how they learned about the show. Before 4:00 pm on Saturday the winning ticket will be drawn and the recipient notified if not in attendance. Pick up arrangements will be made between the committee and the winners.

Silent Auction

We will have a silent auction to raise funds for [St. Stephen's Anglican Church](#) and [The Calgary Alliance for the Common Good](#) and on Friday and Saturday. If you have a small item that you would like to donate to support these causes, please let us know.

Takedown

The show closes at 4:00 on Saturday, October 3. All participants are asked to wait until the visiting public has exited the venue before packing up their artwork. Artists are responsible for safely removing their unsold work and ensuring that none of their work is missing. Participants are then asked to help take down the easels.
